

## Categories and Definition regarding Budget for Children and Youth

Item	Definition and Items
Development	<p>Definition: rights development and educational promotion, career counseling and vocational training, Culture Promotion and social participation</p> <p>Item: training and promotion on relevant child's welfare and rights regulations, career counseling and vocational training for teenagers, job training and culture promotion and development.</p>
Welfare	<p>Definition: relevant measures for lightening financial burden and family supporting.</p> <p>Item: child care services, medical subsidies, childbirth subsidies and programs, child care allowance, placements, welfare service promotion for disabilities, social assistance, living subsidies, families encountering extreme hardship, adoption matching services, unmarried teenage pregnancy counseling, social insurance (including insurance premium and insurance coverage), awards and subsidies for disadvantaged families, student accident group insurance and transportation subsidies.</p>
Health	<p>Definition: physical and mental health promotion and treatment.</p> <p>Item: mental and physical health of children and youth, illness prevention, preventive healthcare, early intervention treatment, prenatal examination for pregnant women, environmental protection and drug rehabilitation treatment.</p>
Education	<p>Definition: preschool and universal education for children and youth.</p> <p>Item: early childhood education, compulsory education, education subsidies, educational promotion, after-school care, subsidies for nutritious lunch and human rights education.</p>
Protection	<p>Definition: measures to ensure children and youth's physical and mental are safe from being neglected, abused or exploited by any type and juvenile justice.</p> <p>Item: classification and management of media, juvenile justice, behavior deviation correction on children</p>

Item	Definition and Items
	and youth at risk of juvenile delinquency, protection services and a mandatory reporting mechanism on child and youth protection, a mandatory reporting mechanism on family at high risk, prevention of children and youth sexual exploitation, tobacco and alcohol addiction, the drug rehabilitation treatment, implementation plans for domestic violence and perpetrators of sexual assault, human trafficking, children and youth labor rights protection, gaming safety and traffic safety.
Overseas aid	Definition: overseas aid plans.
Other	Definition: children and youth protection and security measures that are not mentioned above.

\* Budget should include research funds.

### **Direct and indirect budget**

Direct budget	Definition: count it as 100% if children and youth are fully benefited. (including administrative and personnel expenses).
Indirect budget	Definition: count it based on the ratio of children and youth populations to the total population, yet if we can know the ratio of children and youth who are benefited, then count it based on the ratio.
